Who can attend	:	Youth participants aged 09 to 26 Years Old Youth age 09 to 17 must be accompanied by Adult Leader International Service Team aged 18 to 26 years old
Registration Fee	:	USD 200.00 per person Includes inland transportation, camping kits, activity kits, food and accommodation
About Camp	:	This camp is of highly interactive programmes consisting of games, discussions, exhibitions, galleries, workshops and talks impacting the young people to take action on the Sustainable Development Goals. This camp will highlights 03 main programme components: 1. Sustainable Development Goals Component – This component will consist of 18 bases mainly aimed to spread awareness and to educate participants on the SDGs.

Caution Money	:	Rs. 10,000/- Non-refundable if selected and not participated and adjustable after participation. Demand Draft is to be send in the name of the Director ' Bharat Scouts and Guides ' payable at New Delhi. Selected candidates will have to pay Rs. 1000/- as administrative charges and Rs. 1500/- for magazine which will be adjusted against caution money and Rs. 2500/- towards Scout/Guide welfare fund.
